



Second Grade Exit Skills

Bible Study

- Recognizes that Jesus loves, died, and rose for us.
- Understands God's plan of salvation through learning selected Bible stories.
- Demonstrates growth in love for Jesus with worship, prayer, music and application of God's truth in everyday life.
- Learns selected Bible verses.
- Understands how school-wide Christian attributes apply to daily living.

Reading/Language Arts/Writing

- Exhibits comprehension of characters, setting, details and main idea of stories read.
- Identifies and exhibits knowledge of sequencing a story or timeline of events.
- Compares and contrasts characters and stories.
- Uses a variety of strategies to determine the meaning of words or phrases in a text.
- Reads literature including poetry and stories.
- Reads and comprehends a variety of informational texts.
- Uses phonetic and other strategies to decode words.
- Reads with fluency to aid in comprehension.
- Recognizes and correctly uses the following parts of speech: nouns, verbs, pronouns, adjectives, and adverbs.
- Uses correct capitalization and punctuation when writing.
- Produces a variety of writings including: opinion, informative, and a re-telling, or narrative.
- Uses complete sentences when orally retelling a story, reporting on a project, or asking questions to clarify.
- Seeks correct spelling and vocabulary by using resources for words and definitions.

Science

- Compares, sorts and records data
- Identifies steps of scientific inquiry
- Makes hypotheses/predictions using cause and effect
- Participates in STEM activities
- Recognizes the stages of life in plants and animals
- Identify and explain ecosystems
- Identifies natural resources and how to conserve them.
- Demonstrates basic knowledge of unit studies by completion of project, oral, and/or written responses

Math (continued)

- Understands and demonstrates knowledge of place value to 1000.
- Reads and writes numbers to 1,000.
- Counts to 100 by ones, twos, fives, tens.
- Compares numbers using $=$, $<$, and $>$.
- Uses addition and subtraction to solve 1 or 2 step word problems.
- Adds and subtracts 2 and 3 digit numbers with regrouping.
- Tells digital and analog time up to five minute increments.
- Knows value of money and counts mixed groups of coins.
- Measures using centimeters and inches.
- Plots and reads points on a graph.
- Identifies and reads a picture and bar graph.
- Recognizes and names shapes and their attributes: faces, vertices and edges.
- Calculates area of a given shape using a variety of units of measure.
- Knows fractions and values: halves, thirds, and fourths.

Social Studies

- Recognizes the contributions of Abraham Lincoln, George Washington and Martin Luther King Jr.
- Understands community in family, school, city, state and country
- Beginning understanding of the U.S. government
- Identifies Urban, Rural and Suburban communities
- Understands responsibilities of a citizen in the community to the environment
- Reads a map using the key to decode information
- Uses a variety of resources to complete written or project-based responses that show understanding of previous studies
